Courteous Parking

Inconsiderate parking throughout the village has been raised again.

The Parish Council has received complaints from members of the public regarding parking on pavements particularly where there is ample room to park in the carriageway. Please can residents be mindful of where and how they park and to think of other users.

The Triangle

Safety concerns over the road surface in The Triangle have been raised and Wiltshire Council have advised that it is delamination of the wearing surface and does not meet their criteria for intervention but they will monitor the situation.

Highways England

Highways England has apologised for the extensive night time A36 closures and subsequent diversion via the A27. They have confirmed they will inform us in future of road closures affecting Whiteparish.

Further Wiltshire Council highways work has been carried out in Miles Lane.
