Temporary Road Closures

- **Common Road**

Wiltshire Council has notified that Common Road, Whiteparish will be closed from 10th April and it is anticipated that the closure will be required until 19th April 2019. This is to enable Wiltshire Council to carry out edge overrun works and improve roadside verges.

- **A27**

Wiltshire Council Highways have provisionally advised the date scheduled for the re-surfacing of the A27 through the village is from 12th June until 16th July 2019. To date we have not received official notification, including the diversion route.
