### COUNCILLOR VACANCY

### A27 RESURFACING

The A27 resurfacing within the village has been completed and it has been confirmed that all of the road markings have been replaced as per the drawing approved by Wiltshire Council, there are no markings left to install.

### TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

- **Common Road**

Wiltshire Council has notified that Common Road (Part), Whiteparish; from its junction with A27 The Street to its junction with Clay Street will be closed on 3<sup>rd</sup> November. This is to enable Openreach to access underground structure for a new customer connection.

### REPORTING INCIDENTS

Further to the Neighbourhood Tasking Groups in our area the police have stressed again the absolute need for all incidents to be reported by the most appropriate means. If incidents are not reported they cannot be investigated nor analysed with other information coming in. This information provides the police with intelligence and enables focused targeting. All information reported regardless of the means used is assessed by the local police team.

There are a range of options for reporting:

**999** – This should be used if there is a crime in progress and/or an immediate threat to a person's safety.

**101** – This should be used if the criminal act has taken place and if there is no immediate threat.

This can be used if it is general information which is not urgent.

**Crime Stoppers** – this is a way of providing information anonymously.

Whatever method is used reporting will be analysed by the police and appropriate action will be taken. All information however provided will be treated in confidence.

If anyone sees or is involved in an incident they should note the time and place, note what happened, get descriptions and if possible photographs. Write it down as it is easy to forget.
