PARISH COUNCIL NOTES

Temporary Road Closure

- Common Road

Wiltshire Council has notified that Common Road, Whiteparish will be closed Tuesday 3rd of August 2021 between the hours of 09:30 and 15: 00. These works involve sealing the recently applied surface dressing. Road markings will be replaced in the weeks following the completion of the works. It is anticipated that the closure will be required for 1 day, however, on occasions, works over run due to uncontrollable circumstances such as plant breakdowns and unfavourable weather conditions.

Grant Applications

Whiteparish Parish Council supported three grant applications at the Parish Council meeting in June:

- Whiteparish Memorial Trust with a grant of £5,000.00 towards resurfacing of the Memorial Trust car park including the lower section used by Whiteparish Surgery.
- Whiteparish Women's Institute with a grant of £32.85 for three litter picking bin bag hoops.
- Whiteparish Cricket Club with a grant of £1,000.00 towards refurbishment of the surface and base of the cricket practice net area, adjacent to the MUGA on the Memorial Ground.

National Bus Strategy/Wiltshire

Wiltshire Council have received a grant as revenue to help improve the provision of local bus services and asked for suggestions for improved or enhanced bus services. The Parish Council agreed that the Clerk work together with Alderbury and Grimstead Parish Councils to propose an additional weekend X7 evening bus service.

Ashmore Close

It was agreed to apply to the Wiltshire Council Community Area Transport Group (CATG) for a new street name plate at Ashmore Close, the current one is in poor condition.

The Triangle and Ashmore Close

The delamination of the road surface at Ashmore Close and The Triangle has been raised with Wiltshire Council Highways again. Highways have inspected again and state there are currently no priority defects on either of them.

Mud on A27

Wiltshire Council Highways have advised that the muddy gully on the A27 near Courtens Garden Centre will be cleared when the correct equipment is available.

Councillor Vacancies

There are three vacancies, to be filled by co-option. Meetings are held approximately every 5 weeks, usually on a Tuesday evening. Please contact the Parish Clerk for further information on joining the Parish Council.
