PARISH COUNCIL NOTES

Local Police Update

PC Rachel Gunn is the neighbourhood officer for the area along with PCSO Jenny Moss and PCSO John Taylor.

They have informed us that they are currently dealing with a spate of non-dwelling burglaries and van breaks in the area. There are a number of enquiries ongoing to identify the suspects, and we should see an increased presence of police in the area patrolling. They would like to reassure the people of Whiteparish that these crimes are being taken very seriously and it is not only Whiteparish that has experienced these. They would like to encourage that any suspicious behaviour is reported via 101 or 999.

The Drove

Further to the notification from Wiltshire Council that, under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 – Section 53, there is an application to add a footpath – The Drove, Whiteparish. The Parish Council discussed the statements made by members of the public and also of the landowners concerned and decided to make no comment.

Haulage Depot, Common Road

The New Forest National Park and Wiltshire Council enforcement departments are still investigating the HGV trailers and containers parked on the access road to Ferns (previously known as BKG Haulage). They are also investigating if the Section 106 agreement between BKG and the local former planning authority is still enforceable. This agreement encompassed the number of vehicles operating from the depot, the no parking of trailers and containers on the access road and a routing agreement for lorries operating from the site. There seems to be difficulties in taking action on lorries parking on Common Road waiting to access the site.

The Parish Council has been asked by the New Forest National Park to monitor the parking of trailers and containers on the access road for a period of 3 months. If residents should see trailers and containers parked on the access road and are able to safely take images with the dates and times please can they email them to the Parish Clerk at clerk@whiteparish-pc.gov.uk
