Overhanging vegetation

Do you own a hedge, bush or tree along your property boundary?

To ensure that the many pedestrians using our village footpaths can use them easily and safely, please trim back any of your plants or trees which overhang the footpaths.

Also do you own a tree or bush with low branches overhanging or protruding into the highway? These may need to be trimmed to allow a safe, uninterrupted passage past or beneath them.

If you have a large awkward tree branch overhanging the main highway, and you live in the [Conservation area of the village](#), you will need to seek advice from the local Tree Officer at Wiltshire Council. Tel: 0300 456 0114 or E-Mail: Planningtrees@wiltshire.gov.uk

Wiltshire Council Highways Authority have advised us that the minimum clearance over a carriageway is 5.1 metres and over a footpath it is 2.1 metres. The Highway Authority has the powers to enforce these clearances.

Please do not cut hedges during the bird nesting period unless there is a safety risk, such as with an obstruction or at road junction sight lines.

Temporary Road Closure

- Ashmore Lane

Wiltshire Council has notified that Ashmore Lane (Part), West Dean will be closed from 4th September 2023 and it is anticipated that the closure will be required for 3 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm.
