PARISH COUNCIL NOTES

New residual waste collection rounds

From 28th February 2022, the residual 'general waste' collection days will change for most Wiltshire residents. Kerbside recycling and garden waste collection dates will not change. All Wiltshire households should receive an information letter effectively providing notice of the changes. In addition, bin hanger information tags will be fixed to the handles of waste containers on the last collection under the outgoing schedule to remind residents of the impending change to collection days.

Jubilee Celebrations

Further to responses received regarding possible Jubilee Celebrations the Parish Council is happy to provide some level of co-ordination by providing a chairperson for a village wide Jubilee Committee. Please let the Parish Clerk know who will be representing and leading the effort of your organisation.

Public Rights of Way

We are very fortunate in Whiteparish to have so many footpaths for everyone to enjoy. Whilst the Parish Council endeavours to make sure all public footpaths are passable if you find any blocked paths, broken stiles, missing waymark signs or any other problems please let the Parish Clerk know.

We would like to remind you to stay on the definitive paths and not to stray on to private land.
