Wiltshire Council has notified that Dean Lane (Part) Whiteparish; from a point proximate to property Ash Lodge for a distance of approximately 50m in a northerly direction to Oak House will be closed from 12th February and it is anticipated that the closure will be required until 16th February 2018. This is to enable SGN to carry out essential gas works.
