PARISH COUNCIL NOTES

Haulage Depot, Common Road

The New Forest National Park and Wiltshire Council enforcement departments are still investigating the HGV trailers and containers parked on the access road to the depot. The Parish Council continues to be asked by the local authorities to monitor this. If residents should see trailers and containers parked on the access road and are able to safely take images with the dates and times please can they email them to the Parish Clerk at clerk@whiteparish-pc.gov.uk

The police have confirmed to the Parish Council that the vehicles travelling along, queuing and parking on Common Road are not committing an offence.

HGV signage at The Green with A27

Following residents' concerns of HGV's travelling along The Green and on to Dean Lane to get to West Dean, the Parish Council was successful in applying to the Wiltshire Council Community Area Transport Group for financial assistance to update the current HGV signage. The new signage should be in place by April 2021.

To consider a request for the relocation of utility pole in The Street

Concerns have been raised regarding a utility pole situated on the pavement near to York House in The Street. Due to its positioning on the pavement, it can make it difficult for pedestrians to pass. This has been raised with Wiltshire Council who have advised it would need to be relocated on private property. Wiltshire Council advised of a recent quote which involved one utility, moving the pole 2 metres at a cost of £25k. The Parish Council decided to not take any action at this time due to the costs involved.

Churchyard Grass Cutting

It was agreed to support the PCC, All Saint's Church with its request regarding financial assistance towards grass cutting of the churchyard.

Whiteparish Memorial Trust

It was agreed to support the Memorial Trust's request with financial assistance towards new safety surfaces for part of the children's play area plus repair of a multi play item.
