

MINUTES of the Annual Parish Meeting of Whiteparish held on Tuesday, 22nd March 2022 in the Memorial Centre, Whiteparish at 7.30pm.

Present: Cllr King (Chairman) and Cllrs Palmer, Bell, Bishop and Pavey.

In attendance: Mrs Maria Pennington, Parish Clerk.

There was one member of the public present and Unitary Cllr Britton.

The Parish Council Chairman started the meeting at 7.30 pm. Councillors introduced themselves.

Acceptance of minutes of Annual Parish Meeting held 19th March 2019

1. Whiteparish Parish Council RESOLVED to approve the Annual Parish Minutes of the meeting held on 19th March 2019 and they were signed by the Chairman.

To invite the residents of Whiteparish to raise any matters of their concerns

2. The member of the public raised concerns regarding:
 - Crime in Whiteparish and what action the police are taking. The Clerk advised that PC Pete Jung had sent his apologies for the meeting this evening however she read out the latest police report for Whiteparish.
 - Speed of vehicles through the village including in The Street. It was reported that there is an active village Community Speedwatch Group (CSW) who would welcome new volunteers. Various traffic calming measures have also been investigated by the Parish Council in co-operation with the Highways Authority, however, due to various reasons have proved to be impractical. By having CSW it helps the village gain additional support from the police regarding speeding.
